



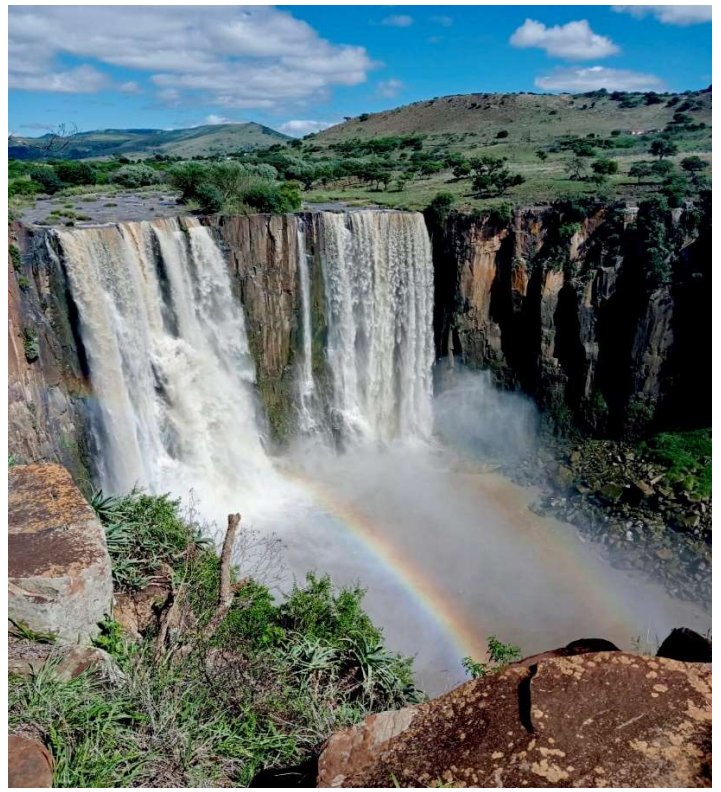
# Zulu Falls

Middelrus

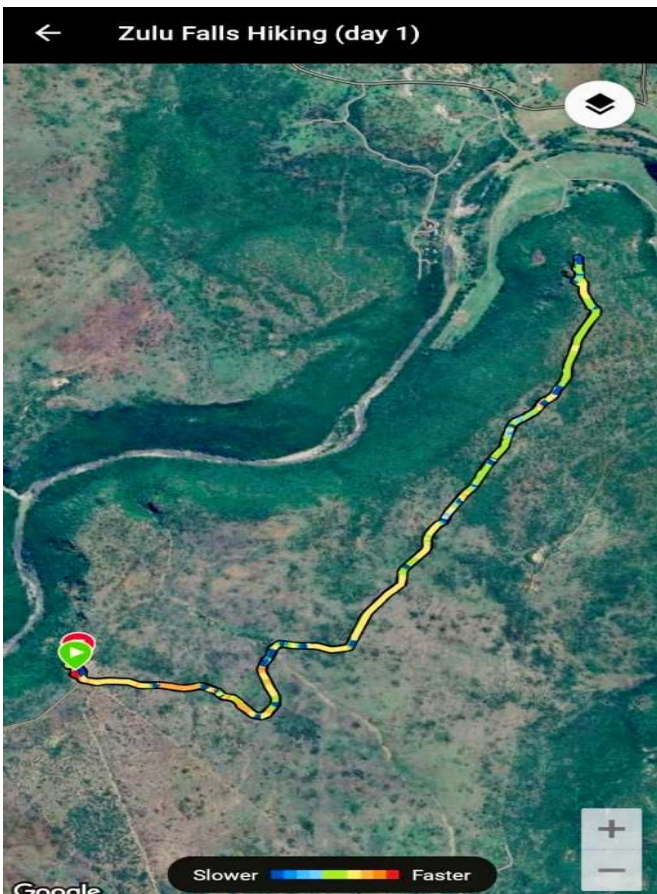
12 - 14 November 2024

Day 1 - was a muddy start. We hiked parallel to the river for about 6.96 kms.
